ICVolunteers is an international non-governmental organization that recruits, trains and coordinates volunteers for non-profit conferences, events and projects. We also offer experienced organizational and management services to event and project coordinators.

ICVolunteers is in particular active in three areas: conference support, cybervolunteerism and language services.

With its headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland, ICVolunteers has continued to expand and now has offices and permanent representation in a number of countries, including Mali, Uganda and Spain.

ICVolunteers, in partnership with Volunteer Centre, founded the ICVolunteers South Africa Desk in Cape Town.

ICV olunteers works with a network of 1,500 active volunteers from age 16 to over 80, coming from some 100 countries.

- Short term: in collaboration with our associate members, in particular for event-related projects both at the local and international levels...



AIDS 2000, held in Durban in 2000, was the first World AIDS Conference happening on the African continent. ICV olunteers took care of the international volunteer team working at the event, including Emmanuel, originally from Congo and now living in Europe, here helping with French interpretation.

### **CyberVolunteers**

We offer through the CyberVolunteering programme internship opportunities ranging from a few weeks to a few months, to new technology experts. Volunteers undertake field projects related to the work, network administration or to the development of software applications.
